- **9-10:15 “Faith Alone: Why Salvation Is All of Grace”**
- If you ask most people about the purpose of religion, they would say it is designed to help you be a “good” person. However, Christianity is different than all other religions. It is a religion not for “good” people but for “bad” people. We are saved not by our good works, but by grace alone through faith alone. This session will explore what makes grace so amazing.

- **9am-10:15am “5 Misconceptions About the Origins of the New Testament Canon”.** Our New Testament is not just one book but is composed of 27 smaller books. But how do we know we have the right books? And who picked these books? And what do we say about “lost” books like the Gospel of Thomas? This session will explore misconceptions about the origins of the New Testament canon and why it can be trusted.
- **10:45am-noon “Scripture Alone: Why God’s Word Is More Powerful Than You Think”** There are many skeptics that doubt the truth of God’s Word. But there are also many Christians that question its value. Is it really that important? Is God’s word really that necessary in the Christian life? This message will explore the importance of God’s word through the text of Hebrews 4:12-13.

Michael J. Kruger is a New Testament scholar and the Samuel C. Patterson Professor of New Testament and Early Christianity at Reformed Theological Seminary in Charlotte, NC. First joining the faculty of RTS in 2002 and serving as president of RTS Charlotte for the past twelve years, Mike has recently transitioned to the role of Chancellor’s Professor where he will teach at multiple RTS campuses while pursuing research and writing. He is a member of the Evangelical Presbyterian Church.

Dr. Kruger graduated from UNC Chapel Hill, earned his MDIV at Westminster Seminary California, and was awarded his PH.D. at the University of Edinburgh, Scotland. He has served as the president of the Evangelical Theological Society, the largest society of evangelical scholars in the world. His work focuses on the Canon of the New Testament, particularly how the Christian church has historically understood which books belong in the Bible. He is one of the world’s leading scholars in the development of early Christianity, early texts of the New Testament, and an authority on the origins and authority of the New Testament books.

He is the author of fourteen books and contributes articles to various publications ranging from Tabletalk Magazine to the Wall Street Journal. Dr. Kruger speaks, lectures, and teaches throughout the United States and the world. He is married to Melissa Kruger; they have three children, Emma, John, and Kate.

Melissa is the Vice President of Discipleship Programming for The Gospel Coalition and the author of numerous books on various topics important to the Christian Community.

Together, Mike and Melissa, make an incredibly dynamic couple of gifted scholars, authors, and teachers, yet you will find them to be down-to-earth North Carolinians who love Jesus and love to encourage the Christian community with their winsome sharing of gospel truths.
